A follow-up activity to re-cap and embed learning from the animated film.

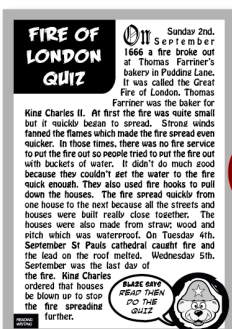

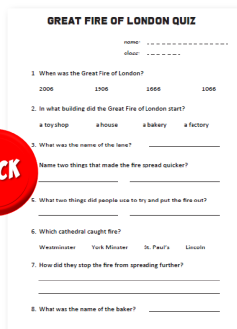

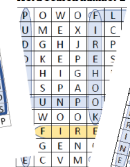
